The Art of Being Together is a juried exhibition of art inspired by the theme of community, sharing life, friendship and inclusiveness. The event celebrates community where everyone – regardless of ability, education, gender, race or religion – is valued for their gifts.

Prior to the show, the art jury will choose up to 10 finalists in both the Finalists and Honourable Mention categories and an overall “Judges’ Choice”. Guests at the show will vote for the “People’s Choice”. Finalists and Honourable Mentions will be announced the week of February 18. Judges’ Choice and People’s Choice awards will be announced at the end of the show.

This is a signature fundraising event for L’Arche Greater Vancouver and also includes a gallery of work created by teams of people with and without developmental disabilities, musical performances, creating a community art piece and a silent auction.

3. Criteria:

This Call is open to artists who:

- Have finished high school (no maximum age)
- Live in the lower mainland
- Can attend the event on March 9, 2013

Rules and Guidelines

- One entry per artist
- The work must be 2D paint or collage, ready to hang which includes wires, hooks etc. Artwork will be hung on easels.
- Works under glass require a mat and clean backing
- Unframed stretched canvas works will be accepted providing there are no staples visible on the sides
- No photography, digital media or print
- The work must reflect the theme "Me and My Community"
- The work cannot exceed 36" in any direction and weigh more than 20 lbs.
- Artists should indicate their interest in submitting a piece in advance by sending in a submission form
- The title name, artist statement and suggested selling price must be included in the submission form. NFS art also accepted
- There is no submission/entry fee

- Artists whose work will be exhibited will be notified after February 18, 2013
- Artists whose work will not be exhibited will be notified after February 18 and must pick up their work prior to March 1, 2013. Artwork that is not picked up after that date will be considered the property of L'Arche Greater Vancouver.
- Artwork will be sold at the price set by the artist. L'Arche Greater Vancouver will receive a 25% gallery fee of the sale.
- Artists are expected to attend the event and take away unsold works. Artists' names will go on a will-call list at the event for complimentary entry.

Admission to the event will be by donation (minimum \$5) and will be open to the public. This event is in support of L'Arche Greater Vancouver, a community of people with and without disabilities.
