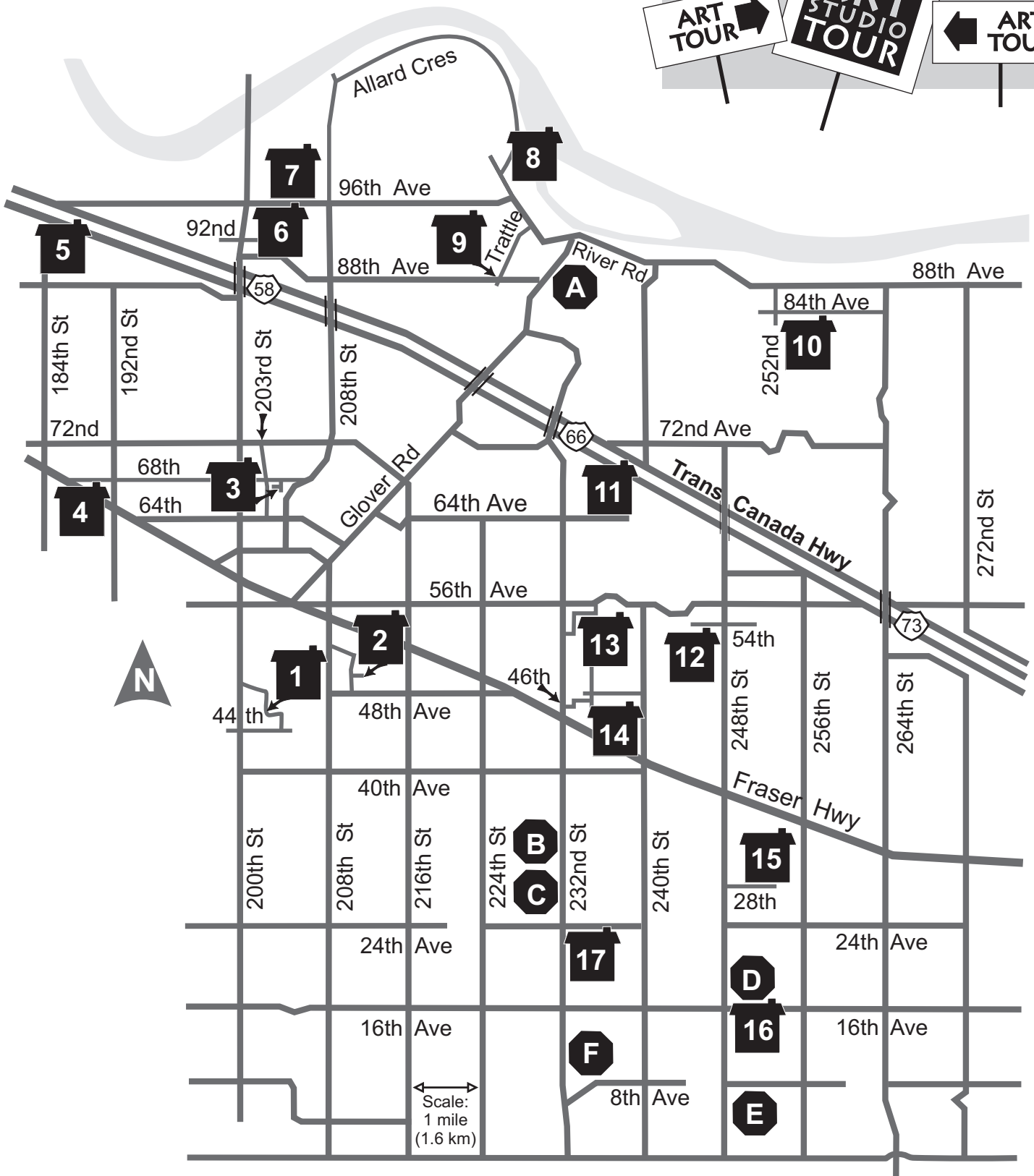
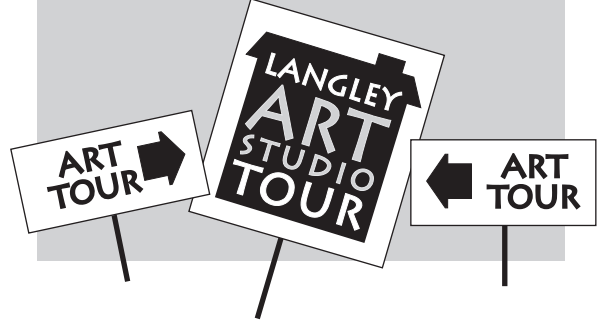


Route Map
